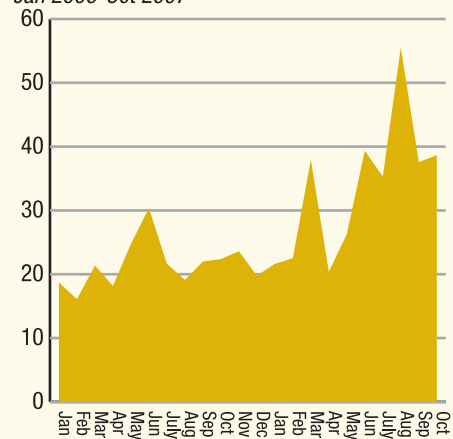

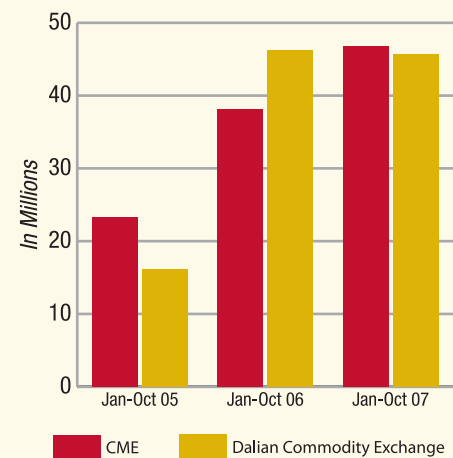

Jan 2006-Oct 2007



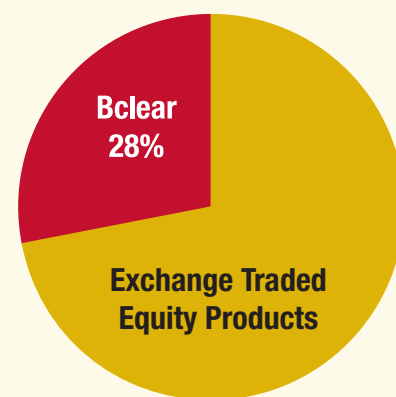

Total Equity Product Volume

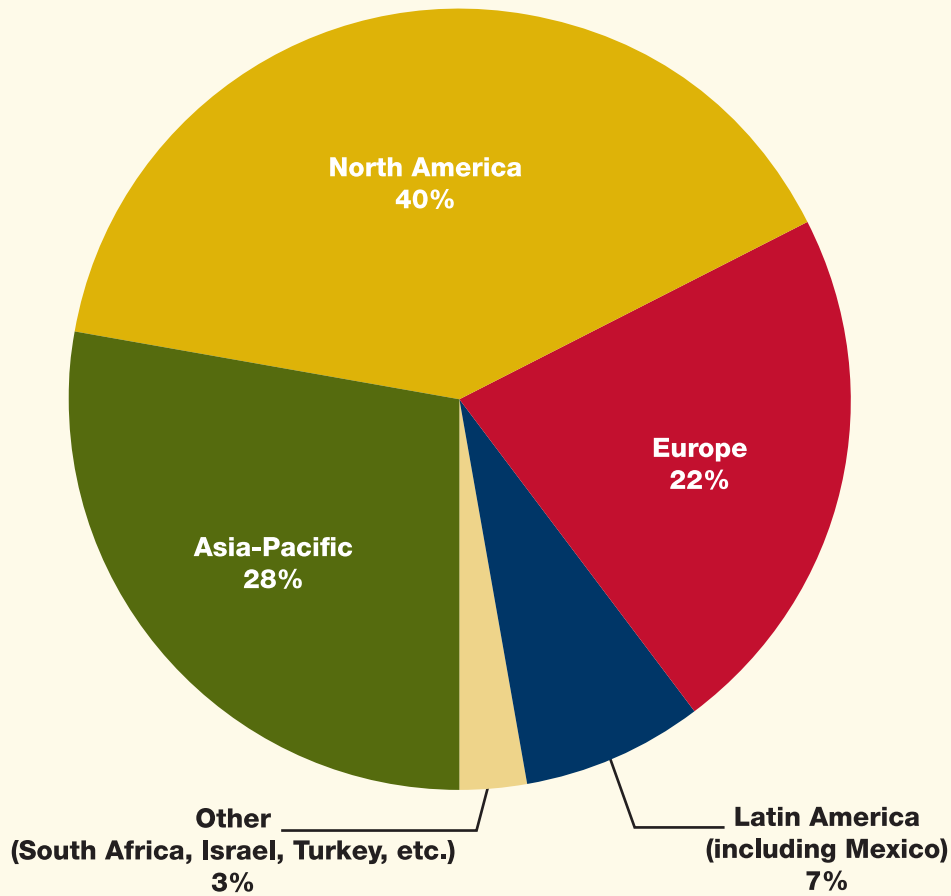

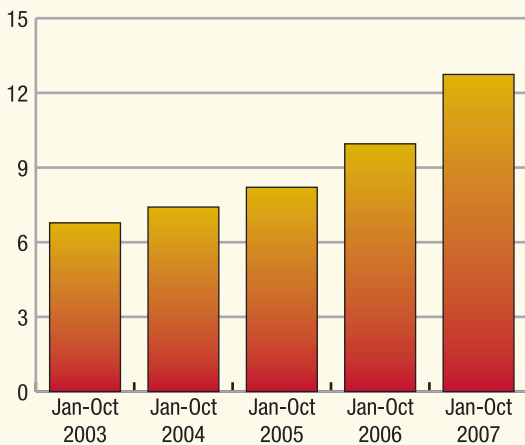
## Global Futures and Options Volume by Region

Based on the number of contracts traded in Jan-Oct 2007

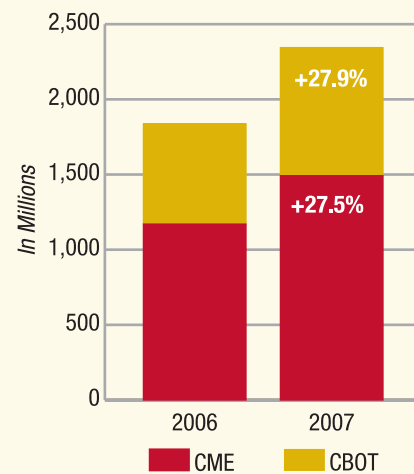


## Growing By Leaps and Bounds

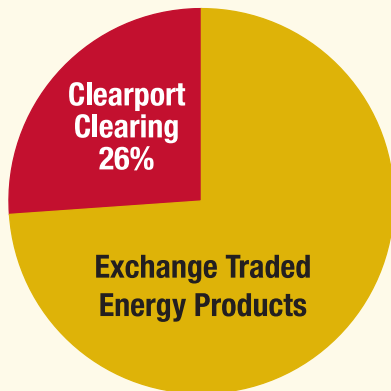

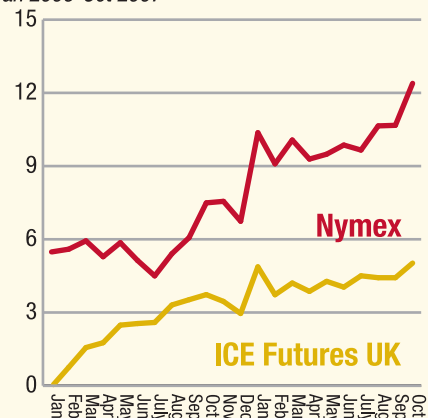
Clearport as a Percentage of Total Energy Products Traded and/or Cleared at Nymex
